G Street re-opening changes “The Bus” routes

MERCED, Calif., Tuesday, November 29, 2011 – G Street in the City of Merced is scheduled to re-open the afternoon of Saturday, December 3. Merced County Transit route 4, which has been detoured for the past 18 months, will return to its regular route along G Street. Route 2, which was also detoured by the closure of G Street, will continue to use its detour route as its former route is no longer possible due to changes in the layout of several streets. Routes 1 & 2 will return to using 26th Street between K and G Streets
