## WHY USE FIXED ROUTES?

When you use TheBus' fixed-route service, you save money right away over the cost of a typical Dial-A-Ride trip. Plus, you don't need to call ahead to schedule your ride. Decide where you want to travel and when you want to travel, without the inconvenience of planning your trip ahead of time or worry about not getting a reservation. Fixed routes allow you to travel with more flexibility while saving you money at the same time.



## WHO QUALIFIES FOR HALF-PRICE FARES?

All seniors age 60 or older and all persons who hold an ADA eligibility card can ride all TheBus' fixed routes (Routes 1-22) for half the regular cash fare. Seniors must present identification that shows their age (such as a driver's license or DMV-issued identification card) or a Medicare card. Medicare card holders may also be asked to show a photo I.D.



## WHEN ARE HALF FARES VALID?

If you qualify for half fares on TheBus' fixed routes, you have the flexibility to travel any time the buses operate. Half fares are not limited to select hours. Travel all day, every day, for half the cost! Merced County Transit fixed-route buses operate Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and Saturdays from 9:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Fixed routes are all routes numbered 1 through 22.
